Re: Filing of Fire Protection District Budgets pursuant to KRS 65.065

After consultation with the County Attorney, I have been advised that the requirement of KRS 65.065 that before moneys can be expended by the Fire Districts a budget must be filed ". . . with the fiscal court to be available for public inspection," is satisfied in Jefferson County if those budgets are filed with Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government (KRS 67C.121).

Upon filing, Metro Government will make copies of those budgets available for public inspection and will either submit a copy to the Department for Local Government or insure that a copy is submitted in compliance with KRS 65.065.

As these actions are executive and not legislative actions, the Mayor is the appropriate party with whom to file the reports. The Mayor has designated you as the recipient of the Fire Protection District Budgets. Please notify the Fire Districts and arrange for compliance with KRS 65.065.
